RE: LETTER OF DEMAND TO ERASKORP NIGERIA LIMITED/ERASKORP GROUP TO REMIT US\$ 832,000, 000:00 TO NNPC/FGN, etc.

We acknowledge receipt of your letter of demand dated 18th February 2019, and the copious documents enclosed.

We would normally not devote our valuable time to respond to a ludicrous letter, replete with inaccuracies, innuendoes and embellishments. However, out of deference to the personages/institutions copied in your accusatory and self-serving letter, we wish to respond as follows:

- I. As you are aware, Eraskorp Nigeria Limited ("Eraskorp") has put enough facts in the public domain to debunk the bogus claim that we are responsible for the losses alluded to in your letter. We have challenged NNPC to produce cogent and credible evidence of Eraskorp's culpability for the alleged losses. Unless we are confronted with such evidence, we are not disposed to engaging anyone in a hypothetical discourse based on media hearsay.
- II. For your information, Eraskorp's engagement to provide security protection for the TFP and similar assets is governed by a subsisting Service Agreement ("the Agreement"). The parties to the said Agreement reserve the right and are at liberty to pursue any and all available legal remedies for a breach of the relevant provisions of the Agreement. Therefore, GUWN's current endeavors are, at best, specious, speculative, and smack of champerty.
- III. While we appreciate the concept of "whistleblowing", as a useful instrument for upholding public probity, we believe such an undertaking should be available to only responsible persons or credible organizations; not those whose sole interest is sensationalism and peddling falsehoods in the guise of protecting public interest. In the instant case, we are of the view that GUWN's self-styled whistleblowing is duplicitous, tainted with bad faith, and lacks any intrinsic value.
- IV. Cognizant of the antecedents and aberrant propensities of the directing mind of GUWN, we have taken the precaution to put relevant security agencies in copy of this letter; to keep them abreast of your latest maleficent and unworthy quest.

- V. With regards to GUWN's threat to institute legal action, we look forward to receiving the Court processes, in due course. We would welcome any opportunity to finally expose you as a busy-body and meddlesome interloper!
